



Chainsaw training & assessment

It is a legal requirement that anyone using a chainsaw during the course of their work must have received training and hold an approved chainsaw qualification. This applies even if the employee only uses a chainsaw infrequently such as a gamekeeper, a farmer cutting firewood or when fencing. Ian is a registered Lantra instructor for chainsaws as well as an NPTC assessor. We can offer basic courses in chainsaw maintenance and crosscutting, tree felling, dealing with windblow etc. or can tailor a course to your specific requirements and provide refresher training. The attached assessment schedules show the required training and standards that need to be achieved to attain NPTC certification.
